English Field features 1,033 permanent chair-back seats in its concrete stands. The stands also include easy-access handicapped sections, which are located at the top of the stands on each side of the center section.

Commitment to Winning

English Field has recently reaped the benefits to Virginia Tech's commitment to winning. Some of the improvements recently made at English Field include \$1 million in new terracing that seats 2,500 and is unlike anything seen in college baseball. Also, a new \$1.5 million hitting/pitching building has been constructed. This 8,000 sq ft facility was dually built for open air and cold weather development. It has retractable cages and can facilitate a full infield.
