Tech concludes the fall season

Squad visits NC State in the final dual meet of 2007

This Week

The Virginia Tech men's and women's swimming and diving teams will wrap up the fall season on Saturday as they visit Atlantic Coast Conference foe NC State's Willis R. Casey Aquatics Center for a 1 p.m. start time.

The H20kies are coming off a strong performance at the Nike Cup from two weeks ago where the men finished ahead of six schools, including ranked North Carolina, to win their first-ever title at the prestigious event.

The women gave the No. 11-nationally ranked Tar Heels a run for their money finishing second out of seven schools ahead of ranked Kentucky and Clemson. As a result, the women have moved up the national rankings from No. 25 to No. 23.

Scouting NC State

Last year, Virginia Tech swept NC State (m: 170-130, w: 201.5-96.5) in Blacksburg. At the 2007 ACC Championships, the Tech men and women finished fourth, while NC State placed seventh on the men's side and 10th on the women's. Two years in Raleigh, the two schools split as the H20kie women won 139-103 and the men lost 155-88.

The Wolfpack men (3-0, 1-0 ACC) enter this year's meet with a perfect dual meet record. They have scored over 200 points in victories against East Carolina, William & Mary and Duke. Two weeks ago, they finished third with 695 points at the Georgia Tech Invite behind Florida State and LSU and ahead of Duke, Miami, Georgia Tech and Florida Atlantic. Stephen Mellor leads the Pack as he currently has the No. 1 time in the ACC for the 200 backstroke, 200 IM and 400 IM.

The Wolfpack women (2-2, 0-1 ACC) have wins over William & Mary and Campbell with the losses coming against Duke and East Carolina. They also took third at the Georgia Tech Invite with 445 points.

H₂Okies Swimming and Diving

Mizzou Dual Challenge, the H2Okie men and women won a combined 13 events and posted several NCAA Championship qualifying times to finish first and second, respectively, at the Nike Cup, which was hosted by the University of North Carolina. Just about every swimmer swam a career or season-high time in at least one event during the competition for Tech's best overall performance of the season.

On the men's side, winners included **Scott Beard** (100 butterfly), **Mikey McDonald** (3-meter diving) and **Trey Stewart** (200 butterfly). Relay victories included the 200 freestyle, the 400 freestyle, the 200 medley and the 400 medley. Contributors in three of those first-place finishes were Beard, **Kaan Tayla**, **Jake Bova** and **Ian deToll**. **Scott Harkins** swam in the 400 medley with Beard, Tayla and deToll to help Tech win the event.

For the women, **Jessica Botzum** led the squad by being the first Virginia Tech swimmer on either side to automatically qualify for the NCAA Championships. The three-time All-American posted 'A' qualifying times in the 100 and 200 breaststroke to win both events. She also posted a 'B' time to win the 200 IM.

Megan Newell (100 butterfly) won the other individual event for Tech. Relay victories came in the 200 medley and the 400 medley. Botzum, Newell, **Jordan McHorney** and **Sara Smith** swam in both events.

ACC Honors

The ACC named **Scott Beard** Performer of the Week for his performance at the Nike Cup after earning the same award just a few weeks earlier against Kentucky. Besides winning the 100 butterfly and helping Tech win four of the five relay events (took second in the 800 free),

For good measure, he took third in the 100 freestyle and 10th overall in the 200 IM.

The senior became this year the first-ever male swimmer to earn the ACC honor at Virginia Tech. Sophomore diver **Mikey McDonald** earned the distinction last year.

Beard also became the first Tech male to win the weekly award twice in a season. **Sara Smith** won the award twice during the 2005-06 season.

Also, for the third year in a row, head coach **Ned Skinner** and the Tech program have earned at least two weekly honors.

Gone for the Holidays

Virginia Tech will enjoy two weeks of holiday training in sunny Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Hokies' annual trip during winter break will run from Dec. 27-Jan. 11.

Next time out

Tech will begin the new year by visiting UNC Wilmington on Saturday, Jan. 12, which will be followed by a visit to Georgia Tech on the 19th. The next home meet, which will be Seniors'/Parents', occurs on Jan. 26 against former BIG EAST foe Pittsburgh.

Broken Records

Virginia Tech has seen already seen a total of 10 school records broken before even reaching the half-way point of the season.

Mikey McDonald started things off for the men by breaking the 1-meter record at South Carolina. He would later break the 3-meter record at home against Virginia. The other four records happened during the Nike Cup. **Scott Beard** broke the record in the 100 backstroke, while **Kaan Tayla** now has the

top time in the 100 freestyle. In the 1,650 freestyle, **Griffin Lutterbein** broke two school records. First, he broke the 1,000 freestyle on his way out to the mile and then concluded the race with a record time.

For the women, diver **Sarah Milton** broke the school record in the 3-meter against Virginia. During the Nike Cup, **Megan Newell** posted the top time in the 100 butterfly, while **Lauren Ritter**, like Lutterbein, posted a record time in the 1,000 freestyle during the 1,650 freestyle race. The 400 medley relay team of **Jordan McHorney**, **Megan Newell**, **Jessica Botzum** and **Sara Smith** also broke a record during the event.

Botzum's Reign

Senior **Jessica Botzum** kicked off the new season as reigning ACC Swimmer of the Year by earning ACC Swimming and Diving Performer of the Week honors for the first time in her career. She posted 'B' cut times in the 100 and 200 breaststroke events while also helping lead the Tech women to two victories.

Oh Captain, My Captains

Virginia Tech has named its captains for the 2007-08 season. For the men's team, senior **Jake Bova** and juniors **Ben Miller** and **Chris Waldheim** will serve as this year's team captains. The women's team will be led by seniors **Jessica Botzum** and **Becky Horning**. Botzum served as a captain last year.

men's and women's swimming and diving teams with a talented squad that has improved by leaps and bounds in their first three seasons in the ACC.

In 2007, his teams continued their assault on the ACC, with both the men and women garnering a fourth-place finish at the conference championships. He has coached all of Tech's first-team All-Americans in

Jessica Botzum (2005, 2007), Gus Calado (2006) and Sara Smith (2007). He has also coached several honorable mention All-Americans over the past three seasons and a handful of ACC individual and relay squad champions in the schools' first three seasons in the conference. This includes 2007 ACC Women's Swimmer of the Year Botzum and Scott Beard, who both both captured conference titles last February.

Skinner came to the Hokies after serving four years as the director of competitive swimming at William & Mary. In his last season at W&M, he coached the Tribe women to a second place finish at the ECACs, while the men were fourth of 40 teams. Skinner was named ECAC Coach of the Year.

The W&M men's team posted

a fourth-place showing at the '98 ECAC Championships and finished seventh in 1997. Before his stint at William & Mary, Skinner was the head coach and aquatics director at Central Connecticut State University for four seasons.

A 1989 graduate of Louisiana State University, Skinner was captain of the 1988 squad that captured the SEC Championship. Skinner is married to the former Allison Cox. They have a three-year old daughter, Samantha.
